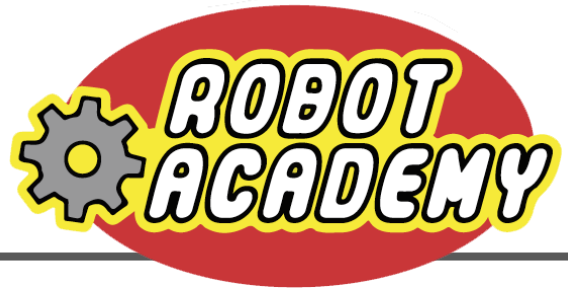


Job Description: Teacher Helper


